Toddlers learn through play, interacting with their environment, and by interactions with other children and their primary caregivers.


The following areas of development are included in our toddler program curriculum:

At CCDC toddlers are able to use their newly discovered independence skills as they explore their environment. Teachers encourage toddlers to use self-help skills as well as providing for basic needs such as feeding, diapering, toilet learning, and napping. Routines are essential at this age to help toddlers regulate their emotions and predict the events that will occur at school. Consistent limits are set for children so they can determine boundaries and begin to learn awareness of people around them.
